“The difference Dolly has made to my life is incredible. I'm so much more relaxed now when I'm at home – I no longer have to worry that I won't hear the doorbell or a smoke alarm.

“Socially, I'm really starting all over again, making new friends and Dolly's a real icebreaker for me. I'm so proud of her!”
